The woman has added that they could not touch it either. I won't debate whether or not that was true or if it was her addition.

I also won't debate over when the death was to occur, whether immediate or eventual. My experience is that Satan tends to deny consequences that inevitably come when one gives into temptation.

I also see that most of us consider the pros and cons of temptation before yielding to it.

There appears to be a heavenly council with YHVH as its leader. They know good from evil. This was one aspect of YHVH's image that Adam and Eve did not originally possess. Immortality was another. No one will eat from the tree of life until the time of the new heaven and earth (Revelation 22:14).

And in the process of time it came to pass that Cain brought an offering of the fruit of the ground to the Lord.

Cain's actions seem to not only be retaliation against Abel, but also against YHVH for favoring Abel's offering and not his.

The encounter between YHVH and Cain seem to cause us to remember that of Adam and Eve because YHVH asks Cain "where is your brother?" and "what have you done?"

This encounter results in a curse that is similar to that of Adam's. Recall that previously, the ground was cursed; this will continue. Yet now, Cain is also cursed. Cain now fears death which was the penalty for eating from the
