• Interrogative pronouns and adverbs are words that are used to introduce questions.

• They are not inflected for gender or number.

• As a result of their nature, interrogatives indicate direct speech.

• Because of this, they are often preceded by a form of (said) which indicates an upcoming quotation.

- 1 is an interrogative particle that signals a question.
- may be translated:
 - If?
 - Whether?
 - Am? Is? Was? Were?
 - Have?
 - Sometimes, context may require a flexibly translated question word.

- The interrogative particle may also be spelled:
 - i when prefixed to most consonants
 - 17 when prefixed to a guttural or any consonant with a sheva;
 - 🗖 when prefixed to a guttural with a qamets
- The interrogative particle is attached to the first word of the interrogative clause.
