So he answered me, "These are the horns that have scattered Judah, Israel, and Jerusalem."	Horns represent the kings of other nations which have scattered Judah, Israel, and Jerusalem.  These four could be represented by Daniel's four beasts or perhaps something different such as other nations that were joined with one of Daniel's four beasts.
A2	Zechariah 1:20-21 (H 2:3-4) <sup>20</sup> Then the LORD showed me four craftsmen. <sup>21</sup> And I said, "What are these coming to do?"	The four craftsmen are to come against the four horns that scattered Judah.

So he said, "These *are* the horns that scattered Judah, so that no one could lift up his head;

but the craftsmen are coming to terrify them, to cast out the horns of the nations that lifted up *their* horn against the land of Judah to scatter it."

So, the original four horns will be punished by the four craftsmen for what they did to Judah.

Gifts were collected from the captives from Babylon in order to make a crown for Joshua (Yeshua) the high priest.  When Zechariah put the crown on Joshua's head, Zechariah said to him, "Behold, the Man whose name (Yeshua) is the BRANCH." He is the high priest.  This was not said to Zerubbabel, a descendant of David. It was said to Joshua (Yeshua), the son of Yehozadak (Yah who is righteous).  This name applies to two priests with the same name!  Joshua the high priest is a sign of a coming Branch who will be a descendant of David. According to Zechariah 6:12, His name is Yeshua (Joshua). He is Messiah – a prophet, priest, and king.

At this point in the text, it is after the Babylonian captivity, and the temple has been rebuilt. The remaining chapters have no dates for reference. We need to bear that in mind that the goal of rebuilding the temple was likely part of a covenant renewal while looking ahead toward a coming Messiah from the Davidic line. In fact, there are several quotations from Zechariah applied to Yeshua in the Apostolic Scriptures.

Bear in mind, some suggest that Zechariah 9-14 was not written by Zechariah and that it is pre-exilic. Other scholars say it's post-exilic but agree that it was not written by Zechariah. All of this, of course, affects the interpretation of the text. I will consider it to be a single text.

Note the battle is between the sons of Zion and the sons of Greece. God will blow the trumpet and defend His people.

Recall that Antiochus
Epiphanes was a Seleucid
Greek. It may be that as

The blood of the covenant is the reason that YHVH is doing all of this. It is a threshold covenant.

Zechariah dismissed three shepherds. We are not told who they were. They likely represented the religious leaders of Yeshua's day.

Later, Zechariah was told to take implements of a foolish shepherd. These represented a cruel, evil, worthless shepherd who YHVH would raise up.

He will be blind in his right eye, and his right arm will be withered (rendered useless). This could be not only physical but figurative of a leader with loss of strength (withered arm) and accuracy (blind eye).

This condition has been applied to Ben Koviza (Bar Kokhva) in the Jerusalem Talmud. This man was declared to be the Messiah by R. Akiva. Bar Kokhva led a revolt against Rome and required a finger of his soldiers to be cut off to show allegiance to him.

We should be on the lookout for such a shepherd – either physical or figurative – in the future.
